All-Dover Christmas Dinner Party will occur on Sunday, December 9 at 5:30 PM.

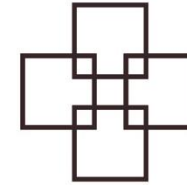
Christmas eve service will occur on Monday, December 24 at 5:30 PM.
