The Ladies Sunday School led by Dr. Cindy Pals is going through Kay Arthur's study called *The Power of Knowing God*.

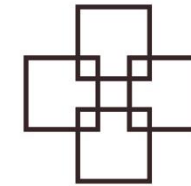
