(4) Pray for the people of Alliance Bible Church as they begin the process that Dover Church has just completed.

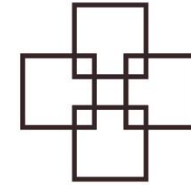
(5) Pray for our family as we forge ahead in this next stage of our journey.
