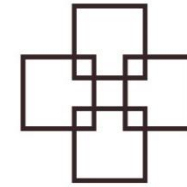
75th Anniversary - We are celebrating 75 years at Dover. Save the dates: September 13, 14, and 15. We will provide more details at a later date.
