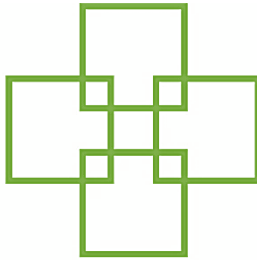

**NORTHWESTERN TO HOST FESTIVAL OF CULTURE:** Northwestern College will hold the Beloved Festival of Culture on Friday, April 23. The public is invited to attend the event, which will take place on the campus green from 4:30 to 7 p.m. With a theme of “A Celebration of Unity,” the event will include an international fashion show, Bollywood dance, live music, inflatables and food from around the world. Northwestern’s Jazz Band will open the entertainment portion of the festival. The meal will be served from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. The menu includes dishes from Afghanistan, Germany, Italy, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, Paraguay and South Africa. The cost, which includes event admittance and the meal, is \$10 for adults and \$5 for children ages 4–11. The public is encouraged to bring lawn chairs; face masks are expected.
