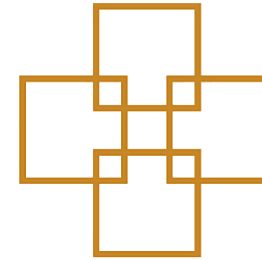

The Orange City Area Food Pantry is preparing for its Thanksgiving distribution. Currently, we need your help in three ways. (1) Discerning who from our congregation or sphere of influence is in need of a food box. **I need to know the size of each family and which ones are in need of diaper vouchers no later than Wednesday, November 8.** Please email (angela.worthley@gmail.com) or text (712-441-5445) me with your ideas about who would benefit from this gift. If the diet of the recipient's family is restricted due to food allergies, accommodations can be made. Budgets can be stretched thin for a variety of reasons (job change, physical or mental illness, unforeseen expenses, changes in household location or size, etc.). I encourage you to think outside the box and help eliminate the shame many of us feel when we need help. My prayer is that we're honest with each other about difficult circumstances, are willing to hear needs when voiced, and feel comfortable receiving assistance when offered. Anyone who is navigating a tough season is eligible for this distribution. (2) We'll need to pack our boxes at American Reformed Church the Saturday morning of November 18 and deliver to the families. Let me know if you're willing and able. (3) Also, the Food Pantry will be going to monthly distributions beginning in January (more on that later) and is creating a list of people who are fluent in Spanish who would be willing to serve as interpreters occasionally on a Saturday morning. If you know of anyone, please let me know. Thanks for being a blessing!

Operation Christmas Child (shoeboxes): This year we will be using our own shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child. You may use a used cardboard shoebox or purchase a plastic shoebox to fill. If you have any extra standard size empty shoe boxes, please bring them to church. Something to consider when selecting items for the shoeboxes: try to create boxes for older kids with supplies that can be used for practicing useful skills? (Sewing, fishing, beads, etc.) They could gain a skill that may allow them to earn money or provide for themselves and their family in the future! Collection week is Nov 13-19, but please have them at Dover church no later than **Thursday Nov 16th** so they can be taken over.

Envision Trip: Pray for our team going to the Envision site in St. Paul, MN, from Nov 3-5 to experience the cross-cultural work being done there.
